No bedding is provided. **\$5.00 per entry. No stall fees. Tack stalls are very limited. Each Draft Horse exhibitor will be assigned 1 free tack stall and \$5.00 per additional stall - Light Horse tack stalls \$5.00 each.**

- Parking instructions: Come in off of Austin Road, turn left on small gravel road north of horse arena. Unload on north side of Radel Pavilion. Don't park in middle of gravel road. Keeping going west behind barns to Elm Street, turn right onto Park Street, turn right onto Austin Road, turn into lot by the water tower - park on Diamond #4.

- No refunds unless a veterinarian certificate is submitted.
- Exhibitors under age 15 are encouraged to wear ASTM Certified Safety Equestrian helmets when riding.
