All stallions must be shown by 18 years and older. **NO bedding is provided. \$5.00 per Entry. No Stall fees. Tack stalls are limited, \$5.00 fee per tack stall.**

- Parking instructions (could change based on weather) verify with Superintendents. Enter Fairgrounds on Austin Road (East side of Grounds) enter gravel road north of horse arena. Unload North side of Radel Pavilion. Park to the side when unloading. Exiting, head West behind barns to Elm Street, turn Right onto Park Street, turn Right onto Austin Rd, turn into lot by the Water Tower – park On Diamond #4.
- No refunds unless a veterinarian certificate is submitted.
- Must have valid/updated Coggins certificate
- Exhibitors under age 15 are encouraged to wear ASTM Certified Safety Equestrian helmets when riding.
